

**Order No. 16/2026  
of the Rector of the Medical University of Gdańsk  
dated March 4, 2026  
on admission limits, recruitment deadlines and  
fees for conducting recruitment  
to the First Doctoral School of the Medical University of Gdansk in  
the academic year 2026/2027**

Based on s. 23(1) and s. 23(2)(2), s. 79(2)(1), s. 200(2) and s. 200(3) of the Act on Higher Education and Science, dated 20 July 2018 (consolidated text in: Journal of Laws 2024: it. 1571, as amended) and §23(1), §23(2)(2), §28(5)(1), §81(2) and §81(3) of the *Statute of the Medical University of Gdańsk* dated June 3, 2019 (consolidated text: Appendix No.1 to the Resolution No. 63/2024 of the Senate of the Medical University of Gdańsk passed on October 25, 2024 in connection with §1(6), §5(1) and §7(2) of the Resolution No.14/2026 of the Senate of the Medical University of Gdańsk passed on March 2, 2026 laying down the terms and procedure of recruiting candidates to the First Doctoral School of the Medical University of Gdańsk

**I order the following:**

**§ 1**

The admission limit to the First Doctoral School, hereinafter referred to as the "Doctoral School", in the recruitment procedure **for the academic year 2026/2027 is 30 places.**

**§ 2**

Recruitment on a general basis, i.e. within the limit of admissions to the Doctoral School specified in §1, is conducted on the following dates:

- 1) electronic registration: **27 July 2026 – 14 August 2026;**
- 2) submission of documents to the Doctoral Students Office: **17 August 2026 – 24 August 2026;**
- 3) English language examination: **10 September 2026 ;**
- 4) prequalification interviews: **21 September 2026 – 25 September 2026;**
- 5) announcement of results on the Doctoral School website: **by 30 September 2026.**

**§ 3**

The recruitment fee to be paid by candidates taking part in the recruitment process to **the Doctoral School in the 2026/2027 academic year is PLN 200 or € 50 for foreigners.**

**§ 4**

This Order comes into force and effect as of the day it is passed.
