

**Scoring system
used to qualify candidates to the First MUG Doctoral School**

1.	Prequalification interview on the planned research project	0 – 60 points, including the score of: 0-50 points– substantive discussion 0-10 points – assessment of the study results (the average minimum score of 30 for the substantive discussion is required).	
2.	Command of the English language, verified with an examination held by the MUG Department of Foreign Languages [SPNJO] or a certificate satisfying the SPNJO requirements	0-4 points	
3.	Command of one additional foreign language (French, German, Spanish), verified based on a voluntary examination held by the MUG Department of Foreign Languages [SPNJO] or a certificate satisfying the SPNJO requirements	0-2 points	
4.	Distinguished Master theses; equal weight: LEK or LDEK result \geq 90%	5 points	
5.	<i>Primus Inter Pares</i> medal	10 points	
6.	Active participation in a research circle (at least 1 year) confirmed with an opinion from the circle supervisor –2 points per research circle	0-4 points	
7.	Documented papers presented by the candidate for research conferences (first author): - oral presentation confirmed with an abstract – 3 points per paper - poster confirmed with an abstract –1 point per paper - another presentation confirmed with a certificate or programme – 1 point per paper	0-6 points	
8.	Awards for the presented papers (listed in it. 8): - oral presentation confirmed with an abstract – 2 points per paper - poster confirmed with an abstract – 1 point per paper	0-6 points	
9.	Awards and scholarships for research activities, granted by institutions other than the University – 2 points per award	0-4 points	
10.	Rector's Awards – 1 point per award	max. 2 points	
11.	Research paper publications: - journals with the Impact Factor \geq 0.5– 3 points per publication - monographs/ chapters in books, satisfying the Ministerial scoring criteria – 2 points per publication - Ministry-scored journals (without IF) or with the Impact Factor < 0.5 – 1 point per publication In the case of students of doctoral studies, the output presented in the process of recruitment for the doctoral studies taken into account.	max. 9 points max. 6 points	
12.	Diploma confirming the completion of studies at another faculty (Master Degree or equivalent)	5 points
