

EVALUATION CRITERIA
FOR THE FIRST DOCTORAL SCHOOL
ON THE BASIS OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE
AND AWARDING POINTS FOR CERTIFICATE HOLDERS

Academic year 2020/2021

Examination verifies the candidate's command of General English and is carried out as a quiz at the University's Moodle website.

The quiz includes 40 questions with 3 different tasks:

- multiple choice - verifies candidates' knowledge of grammatical structures and vocabulary at B1-B2 level. Grammatical structures tested, among others: tenses, passive voice, reported speech, conditionals, modals verbs. Vocabulary comprises words, expressions and phrasal verbs from variable word groups, typical of General English.
20 pts
- cloze test - checks candidate's understanding of sentences with gaps which they fill with one word so that the text is correct grammatically and logically. Candidates put in their own word into each gap.
10 pts
- word formation - tests knowledge of speech parts derivation by means of word building formants. Candidates use a given word to transform it into a correct form and put this form into a gap.
10 pts

Examination time: 25 minutes

When a candidate has completed the first page and clicked to the next one, going back to the previous page is not possible.

To take the quiz you need to log in to both University e-learning moodle website and Zoom.us video-conference (the details will be sent before the quiz). The candidates should make sure that their computer, camera, microphone are working correctly and that the Internet connection is sufficient. Zoom video-conference enables teachers to observe candidates during examination. Upon teachers' request students shall share their desktop to present the browser with the e-learning platform on.

To document any technical difficulties when logged in to the e-learning website or the video-conference software the candidate is eligible to show the recording of his/her desktop taken during the quiz with the help of the tools available online.

The scored percentage is converted according to the scale adopted for the First Doctoral School at GUMed:

points	Percentage

The candidate may score points for knowledge of English also on the basis of certificates issued by world organizations certifying language command or graduation diplomas from foreign universities.

Our Department accepts grades scored at formal examinations when confirmed by requisite certificates. 5 points are granted upon presentation of the following certificates:

- 1) FCE: at least grade C
- 2) CAE and CPE – no matter which grade
- 3) TOEIC (580 points or more)
- 4) TOEFL (500 points or more) – we accept the certificate issued in the past two years (in accordance with the TOEFL regulations)
- 5) IELTS (above 5.5) we accept the certificate issued in the past two years (in accordance with the IELTS regulations)
- 6) TELC ENGLISH C1 (220 pts or more)
- 7) A diploma of graduating from studies abroad (also Polish diploma of graduating from studies in English – English Division are respected)

Certificates or diplomas of institutions or universities certifying knowledge of a foreign language at a lower level, or other certificates, which are not adequately described i.e. those, which do not give information allowing interpretation and comparison of results with requirements of the European Union on the level of language proficiency – *The Common European Framework* of Reference for Languages (CEF or CEFR, pol. ESOKJ) will not be considered.
